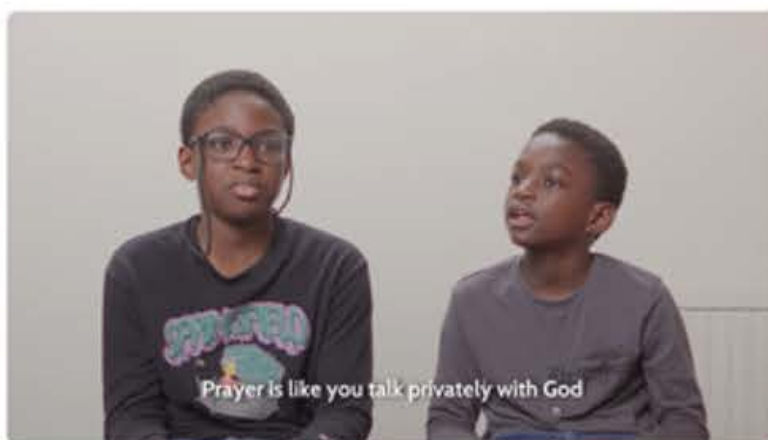
Grace said "I liked writing my own version about what I want to pray for"
