St Ann's Bookshop The St Ann's Bookshop is now located in the office foyer and can be purchased at any time. All books £1.50.

Shakespeare Plans to bring a new £26m Shakespeare playhouse to Prescot have been given the go-ahead. Knowsley Council's planning committee voted unanimously in support of the major development, which they believe will attract thousands of visitors and students to the town. Prescot was once the only English town outside of London to have a purpose-built indoor playhouse. This is great news for the area on the anniversary of Shakespeare's death.
