Dear Parents/ Carers

I am pleased to inform you that your child is eligible for a place at school during the closure, subject to an identification check. To secure your child's place tomorrow, suitable ID to evidence that a parent/ carer is a critical worker must be shown to a member of staff on the gate (e.g. ID badge or pay slip). Without satisfactory ID, your child's place will be withdrawn. This is because the government want to limit attendance to reduce the number of contacts that all of us have with people in other households.

Please find below the arrangements for your child from tomorrow (6.1.21). If your circumstances change, and you no longer require the place, please inform us via the office.

We will be offering a sibling drop off. The sibling drop off is the side gate. This is optional, siblings are encouraged wherever possible to enter with their home group. We are unable to offer sibling collections. The sibling drop off will work as follows:

Surnames beginning with:	Time to drop off at sibling gate
A-H	8.30am
I-P	8.40am
Q-Z	8.50am

So that school can fulfil its safeguarding and attendance duties, attendance of pupils who have a place at school is full time and not flexible. For the foreseeable future, children who previously had a school meal will continue to have this provided by Mellors. If this changes you will be informed. Toast/ fruit will continue to be available. Children should wear full school uniform and continue to bring their book bag and water bottle to school each day. If you indicated that you require BASE provision, you will be sent a separate survey. The protective measures outlined in our risk assessment will continue to be in place. Our risk assessment can be found on our website.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank parents/ carers for their understanding and cooperation. I know that this period has been an anxious and challenging.

Any child showing symptoms of the virus should not attend school, and should remain at home, as should any siblings. Parents should immediately arrange for their child to be tested. Where the child tests negative, they can return to school. Where the child tests positive, the rest of their Home Group will be sent home and advised to self-isolate for 10 days.

If a child is unwell and is showing any symptoms of the virus whilst in school they will be immediately isolated away from the other children and taken to an allocated room, and a phone call home will be made asking you to immediately collect your child. The child will then wait in isolation for their parent to collect them; we would ask for you to collect your child promptly.

Parents/Carers should inform school if a member of their household tests positive, or displays symptoms of Covid 19.
