ENGLISH TEACHING AND LEARNING



Reading books

From today, no paper books will be sent home with children. Instead, children will be expected to read using Bug Club when they are at home as was the case in during the Spring and Summer terms of 2020. If your child reaches a point where they don't have any books to read on Bug club, please contact your child's class teacher via Teams and they will sort it out for you.

Reading diaries

Reading diaries will also need to stay at home for the foreseeable future. Please continue to sign these diaries on a daily basis as we will backdate everything as soon as we all return to school in order to continue with our reading certificates.

Spellings

Spellings will still be set as homework via Teams and the weekly spelling test will still happen either in school or remotely depending on where your child is currently learning. Any spelling test done via our remote learning platform will need to be submitted in the same way that daily lessons are (usually a photograph of the completed activity).

This week children enjoyed watching Reverend Alan's Epiphany service. As children will no longer be receiving paper books and their diaries will no longer be being checked,




As children will no longer be receiving paper books and their diaries will no longer be being checked, from Monday 11th January, children should not continue to bring their book bag to school.
