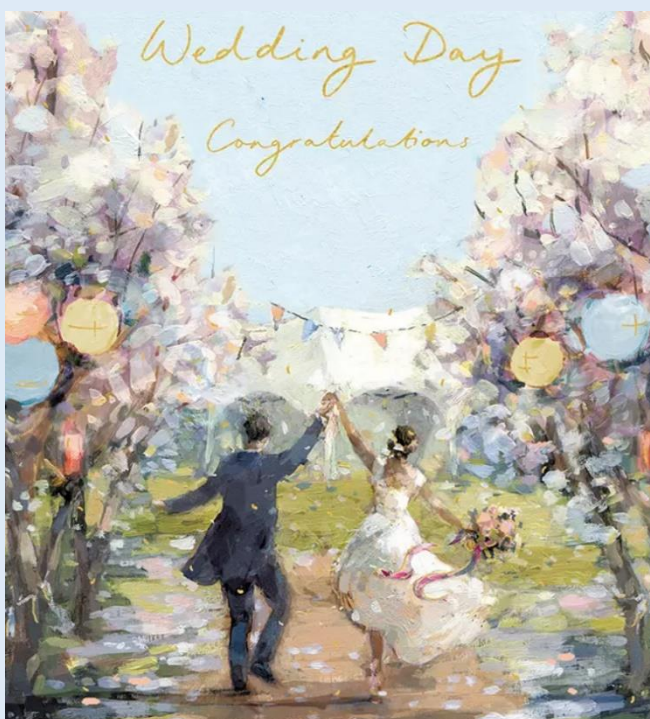

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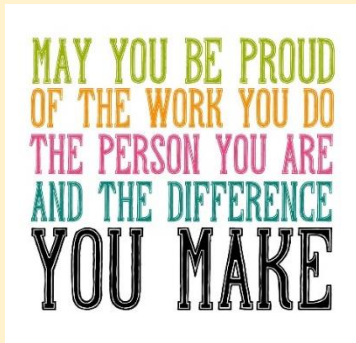
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GOOD LUCK MISS REED

DROP OFF & COLLECTION ARRANGEMENT FROM SEPTEMBER 2021

Next year staggered starts and finishes will cease.

MORNING DROP OFF

- School will start for all pupils at **8.50am**.
- School gates will open at **8.40am** and be locked at 8.50am prompt.
- Registers will close at 9.00am.
- Anyone arriving after 8.50am will need to enter school via the main entrance.
- Anyone who enters via the main entrance will be marked in the register as late.
- All pupils should enter the school gates and enter their classroom via their classroom door.
- Parents/ carers can accompany Early Years, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils to their classroom door.
- Y3 – Y6 pupils should walk through the gates unaccompanied.
- Pupils/parents can access the school site via either the front or back gate.

THE YEAR AHEAD

Mixing & Bubbles

Following the summer holidays we will no longer be operating in consistent 'bubbles', and alternative arrangements to avoid mixing will no longer be in place. This means classes will be able to work together once again, staggered starts and finishes will cease and we will resume activities such as collective worship, using the hall for lunch and inviting parents to events. However, if there is a local, school or class outbreak, following advice, it may be necessary to re-introduce some or all of the control measures we have had in place during the past year. These decisions will not be taken lightly.

Close Contacts & Isolation

From the 16th August 2021, children under the age of 18 years old will no longer be required to self-isolate if they are contacted by NHS Test & Trace as a close contact of a positive Covid19 case. Instead NHS Test & Trace will be in touch and inform them they have been a close contact and advise them to take a PCR test.

When an individual develops COVID-19 symptoms or has a positive test

Pupils and staff will continue to follow public health advice on when to self-isolate and what to do. Pupils should not come into school if:

- they have symptoms,
- have had a positive test result
- or other reasons requiring them to stay at home due to the risk of them passing on COVID-19 (for example, they are required to quarantine).

If anyone in school develops COVID-19 symptoms, however mild, they will be sent home and instructed to follow public health advice. If a pupil is awaiting collection, they will wait in the isolation room, supervised by staff wearing PPE. The household (including any siblings) should follow the PHE stay at home guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) infection.

Asymptomatic testing

Testing remains important in reducing the risk of transmission of infection within schools.

Confirmatory PCR tests

Staff and pupils with a positive LFD test result should self-isolate in line with the stay at home guidance. They will also need to get a free PCR test to check if they have COVID19. Whilst awaiting the PCR result, the individual should continue to self-isolate. If the PCR test is taken within 2 days of the positive lateral flow test, and is negative, it overrides the self-test LFD test and the pupil can return to school, as long as the individual doesn't have COVID-19 symptoms.

Control Measures

At school we will continue to:

1. Ensure good hygiene for everyone including hand washing and respiratory hygiene
2. Maintain our cleaning regimes
3. Keep occupied spaces well ventilated
4. Follow public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of Covid19

Attendance

School attendance is mandatory for all pupils. Holidays during term time will continue to be unauthorised and parents should bear in mind the impact on their child's education which may result from any requirement to quarantine and isolate upon return, in addition to the holiday itself.

Remote Education

Next year school will continue to deliver remote education for pupils who are well but need to self-isolate because they have tested positive.

It is worth bearing in mind that the operational guidance the DfE has set out for primary schools, is subject to change, and no doubt there will be updates. As always, we will endeavour to keep you fully informed and up date you at the earliest opportunity.

BREAKFAST & AFTER SCHOOL CLUB (BASE) UPDATE

We are delighted to announce that, from September, BASE will return to run from the studio and the drop off and pick up for BASE children will be at the small, blue door to the right of the main entrance, close to the pedestrian walkway. From September, in line with current COVID guidelines, BASE will no longer run in year group bubbles. Instead, children from EYFS – Y6 are welcome to attend BASE together.

This week, if your child has a place in BASE you should have received a letter detailing further arrangements. If you would like a place in BASE or further information, please contact the school office.

YEAR 6 LEAVERS SERVICE

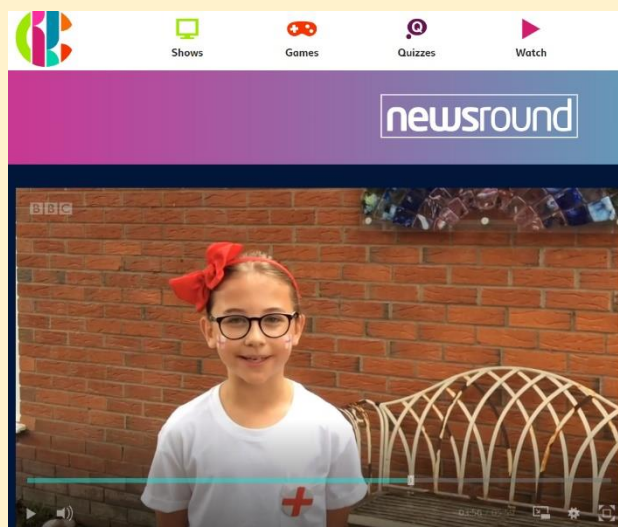
The Year 6 Leavers Service will be uploaded onto You Tube on **Wednesday 21st July**.

In the event of inclement weather, the event will unfortunately be cancelled and will take place without an audience in our school hall.

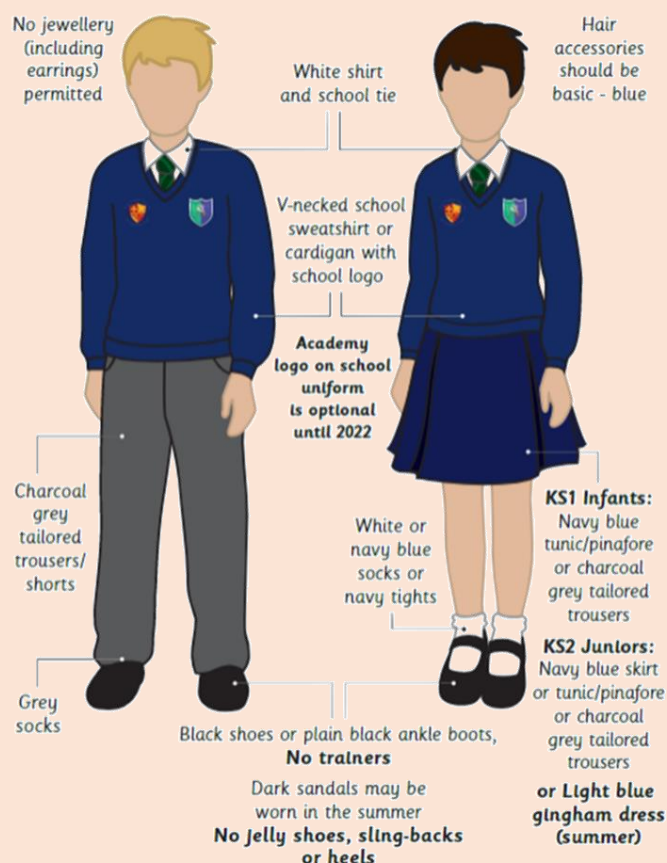
In order to plan for all eventualities though, our Y6 children will also take part in our whole school Awards ceremony in church which will be filmed and uploaded onto our You Tube account.

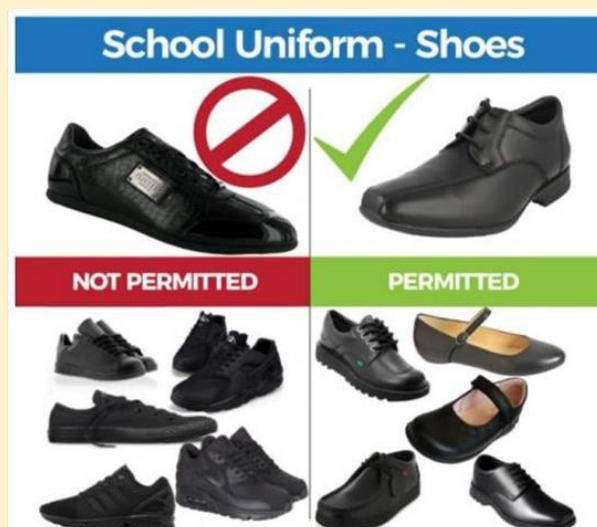

WHATSAPP: GROUP CHATS

You must be at least 16 years old to register for and use WhatsApp. WhatsApp is a free messaging app that allows you to send messages and videos

Group chats

One of the main features is that it has a Group chat function that are set up by one person (who is the admin). Everybody in the group, even if they're not one of your child's phone contacts, will be able to see all messages within that group. *If your child is added to a group with someone that they have previously blocked, that person can still see their messages and send them messages within the group.* You can leave a group chat at any point so talk to your child and encourage them to leave any chat that makes them feel uncomfortable.

Change Group Privacy settings

In settings, you can change who can add your child to groups, for example, you can change the settings to 'my contacts', which means that only those in your child's contacts can add them to a group.

Online Bullying

WhatsApp has been used in instances of online bullying, for example sending nasty messages or sharing images of other children without their permission to embarrass them. It's important to have regular chats with your child about their online life and that they understand that they must talk to you or another trusted adult if they are being bullied.
