#### **TT ROCKSTARS**

Has your child been accessing TTRS? Have they been part of the winning class in the recent battles?

All children in Y2 - Y6 have a Times Tables Rockstars Log in to support their times tables knowledge and all children in EY, Y1 and Y2 have a Numbots log in to support their Number bond knowledge.

TTRS is an excellent way for children to rehearse and practise their times tables facts and we encourage regular and often use of this online platform. On TTRS, there are various game types such as: Garage, Studio, Arena as well as the famous tournaments between classes that take place, these different game types all offer something different with some testing on times tables set solely by your child's class teacher for your child and others testing on all facts. Little and often is the best way for

your child to improve in their times tables facts. Regular teaching of times tables takes place at school and this is embedded with frequent practise on such platforms. We hope that you will be able to support your child with their use of this platform.

Numbots is an online game that focusses on a child's recall and understanding of number bonds and addition and subtraction facts. These are critical foundations within a child's Mathematical knowledge and will support them in their developing confidence, competence and fluency. Children progress through different levels, earning coins in order


