- Introductions
- Home School Diary. LR explained that we are in the process of updating our school diary to ensure it remains a useful document for parents and school.
  - Parent Forum identified that different diaries for Key Stages, information to aid teaching / learning are helpful – using diary to help with homework (references to pages)
  - SLT to consider if there is too much in diary? Are flags / body parts / key facts needed?
  - 100 books to read is a great addition to the diaries.
  - Curriculum maps for each year group may be a good addition to the diaries.
- School Aims – will be reviewed this year and into next year.
  - Discussion on school aims – what do parents want for their children in a primary school?
  - nurture, equality, individuality, high expectations, resilience, independence, diversity, safe, secure, happy, belonging, rights of the child, community – church link, wider provision in school – opportunities, confidence, something for everyone.
