

#### SHINE PROJECT

Years 5 and 6 have been taking part in a reading project called 'Are you really reading?' since October. The project has formed the basis of our guided reading sessions and all children have been developing their reading skills using techniques such as hashtagging to summarise texts and placing events in chronological order to master the skill of sequencing. The project started off with only three schools (St Ann's being one of them) but is building momentum and will be branching out into many other primary schools next year. Due to this, the project leader will be visiting St Ann's on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> April to film some guided reading sessions so that other schools can be shown some of the different reading techniques that the children have mastered - very exciting!

#### YEAR 4 AND 5 SWIMMING CHANGES

Next half term we will be making some changes to our school swimming timetable. In order to ensure that Year 5 have received their full allocations of lessons Year 5 will continue to go swimming on a Friday morning for the first 3 weeks after half term. Dates for Year 5 swimming


## TOWN TROOPER FOOD BANK APPEAL



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
