Year 6 Mentoring conversations will take place on Wednesday 27th February. The results of the recent Assessments will be given to parents.

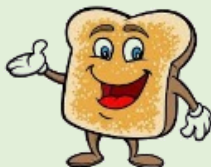
COMMUNICATION

TOAST

For the next half term the payment item is now showing on your ParentPay account and payments should be made by 25th February. If you have not made by payment by 25th February we will issue a reminder by text. If payment is still not received by the date stated in the reminder we will be unable to provide your child with toast for the ensuing half term.
