Break fast Club

The Breakfast Club provides a safe and stimulating environment for your child between the hours of 8am and 8.50am. We offer a range of cereals, toast, crumpets, water, milk and a selection of fruits. Children attending the Breakfast Club also have access to a range of physically and mentally stimulating activities along with a selection of play equipment. There are social benefits as your child has the opportunity to mix with other children from differing age groups.

After School Club

The club provides high quality childcare at the end of the school day from 3:15—6pm for children aged 4-II. A safe, secure environment where children are cared for by qualified staff that have experience in providing play activities for young children. We provide a wide range of activities to meet the needs of individual children that include crafts, sports, table top activities, outdoor play. Children can access the Computing Suite, outdoor areas, musical instruments and a range of toys, games and play equipment.
